## OPTION 3 Medicaid for breast and cervical cancer clients who meet the following criteria:

- 18-64 years old
- Indiana resident
- U.S. citizen or legal resident for more than five years
- Diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer; entering or actively receiving treatment
- Are under 200% of the Federal Poverty Level

## Hallmarks of OPTION 3:

- Rapid, efficient enrollment and review process
- Closely monitored and compassionate navigation with an IDOH nurse
- Premium-free
- Higher income threshold than other Indiana Medicaid programs
- Traditional Medicaid that includes reconstruction, vision, and dental coverage

## Process for OPTION 3:

- Patient or provider/navigator contacts OPTION 3 coordinator
- Coordinator speaks with patient or authorized representative
- Application packet is sent, along with instructions, to patient or provider
- Application is completed and submitted with required ID and pathology to coordinator. Reviewed and forwarded to FSSA
- FSSA staff processes application, conducts interview, and makes eligibility determination. If approved, a PID number is issued.

## OPTION 3 and MA 12 are sister programs

- Medicaid is available through MA12 for breast and cervical cancer treatments for the duration of their treatment if they are enrolled through the Indiana Breast and Cervical Cancer Program. (IN-BCCP)
- Option 3 is the same program for individuals who are enrolled from a provider outside of IN-BCCP
